# THE CENTER FOR CONSERVATION LEADERSHIP ADMISSION INFORMATION APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 18, 2016

The Center for Conservation Leadership (CCL) seeks high school students from diverse backgrounds with a keen interest in the environment and enthusiasm for the outdoors. The year-long CCL Program is challenging, rewarding and fun! Students applying to the CCL Program must make a commitment to all three components of the program: summer experience, school year workshops and environmental stewardship project. Upon completing the three components, each student receives a certificate recognizing his/her achievement.

### The program is comprised of:

- A three-week residential summer experience, June 13 July 1, 2016
- Work days and educational seminars (2016 summer; 2016-2017 school year)
- Mentored environmental stewardship project completed by March, 2017

### To apply for the Center for Conservation Leadership Program:

- Students must have completed 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> grade in 2016
- Student must agree to participate in all three components of the program (see above)
- Students must submit all application materials by March 18, 2016

### **Application materials include:**

- Completed application questions
- Recommendation form
- Financial aid materials (if applicable)

### Financial Assistance

### Need-based financial assistance is available!

Interested applicants should include the following information with their application:

- A parental statement indicating need, qualifications or special circumstances
- A copy of the most recent tax return must also be attached
- If the applicant qualifies for free lunch at school, please send that documentation

### **Looking Ahead:**

- Upon receipt of application, students will be contacted for an interview
- Students will be notified of their admission decision by April 1, 2016
- The Program tuition is \$3,250. This includes tuition, room, board, transportation, and activities (*Financial Aid is available, please see above*)
- A non-refundable \$200 deposit is required upon acceptance

### **Beyond the CCL Program**

Students who complete the CCL Program are encouraged to apply for CCL's High School Internship Program (HSIP), a comprehensive program incorporating environmental education, enhanced leadership development, an internship and a week-long trip to reinforce skills and principles learned during the summer.

CCL seeks motivated 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students from diverse backgrounds with a keen interest in the environment and a passion for the outdoors. The CCL Program is challenging and rewarding. It requires commitment and responsibility and is comprised of:

- A three week residential summer program in northern Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula.
- Several one-day week-end field trips, workshops and guest speakers during the school year designed to supplement the summer experience, expose students to career avenues and reinforce the social relationships formed during the summer.
- Mentored environmental stewardship projects.

At the end of the first year, CCL awards students who successfully complete the program with a Certificate of Conservation Leadership. This certificate entitles students to use the Center for Conservation Leadership as a resource for expanded environmental education opportunities and internships.
